Gina Hayworth earned the Regional CFC Hero for the Combined Federal Campaign of the Pikes Peak Region.

Gina has worked at the Pueblo Post Office since 1981 (24 years in February), starting in CFS before becoming a letter carrier. She is the first to volunteer when any auxiliary projects come up, and has been working with the Campaign for about half of her Postal career.

While the next highest ratio of employees to keyworkers in the Postal Service is 59 to one, for the past five years Gina has been solely responsible for contacting about 254 employees in several offices in the Pueblo area. Even with this daunting task, she still manages to achieve a 50% participation rate and has collected 17% of the USPS total by herself.

Gina continues to contribute her skills and abilities to represent the Postal Service in a positive manner. She represents a model keyworker – year after year.

Gina has embodied the volunteer spirit in her personal life as well as in her career, by working as a Sunday school teacher and volunteering at the local Humane Society. She holds a teaching certificate in elementary education and hopes to return to that field upon her retirement from the Post Office, which we hope will not be for a long time.
